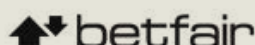

A tribute to

“ Conquering ”

Tasmanian thoroughbred racing lost one of its modern day champions on 11 September, when Conquering collapsed after the finish line in what was his first outing since capturing the prestigious weight-for-age Thomas Lyons Stakes in February, 2011.

The nine-year-old suffered a heart attack during the running of the Members Sprint Handicap in which he lugged 66.5kg, but not a weight he was unaccustomed to carrying.

His trainer Charlie Goggin rushed from the grandstand but by the time he reached his stable star, the gelding had already taken his last breath.

Conquering (the gelded son of Dangerous) had earned legend status amongst the rank and file of Tasmania's thoroughbred industry, not only because of his impeccable record but also for his incredible will to win.

It was Conquering's courage that earned him the warhorse tag.

“There can be no denying that this horse became something of a legend and that's because he was so honest and brought a lot of joy to a lot of people,” Goggin said.

“His natural high cruising speed was a big asset but it was his courage and ability to break the hearts of his opposition that set him apart from most.”

Conquering was often headed in a race but the champ would refuse to wilt and would fight back to savor the joys of victory.

In the 2008-2009 season he broke the record for the most number of weight-for-age races in a season by winning five in succession that ensured him being named Tasmania's Horse of the Year for the second time.

Conquering was partnered many times by top Tasmanian jockey Stephen Maskiell who had a great association with the gelding and he too was upset, especially when he returned on the race winner Western Wager only to see Conquering laying idle on the turf.

“ I couldn't believe that it was Conquering when I was bringing Western Wager back to the unsaddling enclosure, Maskiell said.

It was such a shock because I rode the horse in track work on Thursday morning and he worked great and in the parade ring today he looked absolutely magnificent, probably the best he'd looked for any first-up run of any preparation.

No other horse has won as much money from races won in Tasmania and his following was enormous because of his incredible will to win.

“Conquering was more than just a great horse he was a Tasmanian icon.”

The horse brought a lot of happiness to me and I'm sure he brought happiness to a lot of horse lovers and punters all around Australia.

He was often headed in his races but when the chips were down he'd go in for the fight and more often than not he'd emerge the winner,” he said.

The day the champ lost his life he was having his 80th start and of those outings he emerged victorious 23 times with another 22 minor placings contributing to his stake earnings of just over \$900,000.

He won numerous races at Listed level with a few of his best wins in Victoria where he won feature races and was placed at Group level with Darren Gauci aboard.

Conquering won a two-year-old race on debut and had the distinction of winning every season he raced.

Eligibility of Supervobis (Vic) horses for Tasmanian race bonuses

Currently, Tasracing pays race bonuses for horses paid up under Racing Victoria's SuperVOBIS (Vic) Scheme in addition to those paid up through Tasracing's SuperVOBIS (Tas) Scheme. A change in the funding arrangements with Racing Victoria has necessitated some adjustments to the bonus eligibility for the current 2YO's. Only SuperVOBIS (VIC) nominated horses from within either of the following categories will be eligible to win Tasmanian race bonuses as 2YO's in 2011/12 and 3YO's in 2012/13:

1. Victorian sired yearlings catalogued for sale at the 2011 Tasmanian magic Millions yearling Sale
2. Victorian sired yearlings bred by breeders whose registered address is in Tasmania

SuperVOBIS (Vic) nominated horses purchased from mainland breeders, either directly or through mainland sales, or as tried racehorses will no longer be eligible to win Tasmanian race bonuses.

Note that the status quo will remain for SuperVOBIS (Vic) registered horses racing as 2YO's and 3YO's this season (2010/11) and as 3YO's next season (2011/12), regardless of origin, with all remaining eligible for Tasmanian race bonuses.

*** For feature races staked at \$50,000 or more, a \$5,000 is bonus payable to Nominator of the winner only, if qualified and paid up through SuperVOBIS (Tas).**

Prohibited Substances

MORPHINE AND THE “OPIUM POPPY”

General:

The poppy grown commercially in Tasmania is known by its botanical name as “Papaver Somniferum”. Poppies contain traces of CODEINE and MORPHINE. Only MORPHINE would usually be detected in the urine because the CODEINE ingested is metabolised to MORPHINE in the horse’s system.

The growing plant has a pale purple flower and the dried pods (seed capsules) (see photo) may appear in fodder and cereal crops. These seed capsules contain sufficient CODEINE and MORPHINE when ingested to result in the detection of MORPHINE, which is a prohibited substance in terms of the Australian Rules of Racing.

The dry pods contain many black seeds (poppy seeds), which may be coated with low levels of MORPHINE. The presence of these little black seeds in the bottom of feed bins or elsewhere in your feed supply may be an indication of the presence of seed capsules in the particular batch of feed.



Racing participants and the rules of racing

The rules of racing, insofar as it relates to Prohibited Substances, require that you the trainer or the owner take all proper precautions to prevent the administration of a prohibited substance to your horse/s. It is considered, having due regard to the definitions and the Australian Rules of Racing, that in circumstances where it is found that a sample taken from a horse, which upon analysis disclosed the presence of MORPHINE was due to ingestion of poppy contaminated feed, the prohibited substance MORPHINE had been administered to the horse. In view of this fact you should consider, unless you are already doing so, examining and inspecting your feed supply more carefully to establish whether any poppy material as described above is evident.

You and your feed supplier

When purchasing cereal feed supplies such as oats, oaten chaff or Lucerne you should enquire from your supplier and/or grower whether:

1. The feed was grown in a paddock, which was previously used for the growing of poppies.
2. If the answer to (1) above is yes, then you should ask what measures were taken to prevent any poppy regrowth.
3. He/She would be prepared to supply you with a written guarantee/declaration or otherwise in respect of the quality of the feed supply purchased, that is, that all precautions were taken to ensure that the feed supply is free of poppy contamination.

Elective testing of non-race day samples

In the event that you find material, which appears to be poppy related you may, at your option take samples of your feed or request stewards to assist in the collection thereof and submit those for analysis to Racing Analytical Services via Racing Services Tasmania. These samples will be considered to be special non-race day samples and the fee will depend on various factors. In such a circumstance stewards would be able to make enquiries to obtain a cost estimate. You may in addition request an elective urine sample be taken from your horse for analysis. The cost of an elective urine sample is again a matter that you should discuss with stewards at the relevant time.

Steward's Segment

FEATURE RACE ARRIVAL TIMES

Trainers are reminded of the following rule relating to the time that you are required to have horses on track prior to race time.

LR14.3(a) Further to the provisions of AR 117 all horses intended to be run in any race shall be brought into the saddling paddock at least one and a half hours before the time appointed for the starting of such race.

(b) No horse, which has been brought into the saddling paddock, shall be removed without the permission of the Stewards.

For the following feature races, horses will be required in the saddling paddock 3 hours prior to the official race time.

- Devonport Cup
- Tasmanian Derby
- Hobart Cup
- Tasmanian Oaks
- Launceston Cup

HORSE

Trainers must provide to the Stewards a veterinary report in relation to any significant veterinary issues, ie respiratory operations, bone chips etc.

The following are examples of, but not limited to, conditions or occurrences requiring notification to Stewards under the provisions of **AR140**:

- Any surgery aimed at correcting a condition that may have adversely impacted a horse's prior performance e.g. upper respiratory tract surgery or surgery to correct lameness, limb inflammation/pain or gait dysfunction.
- A horse is required to have a long period of rest to heal an injury sustained in a race eg tendon/ligament strain.
- Lameness or musculoskeletal inflammation/pain.

Injury to any part of the body which could potentially adversely impact on the horse's performance or consist of a welfare or public perception issue on race day, or

- have resulted in an interrupted preparation.
- Any condition or occurrence that has resulted in a horse missing consecutive days of normal exercise or sufficiently interrupted, and thus adversely impacted, a horse's preparation for its next race.
- Any systemic illness that has adversely impacted on a horse's health or wellbeing or may have resulted in an interrupted preparation eg colic attack, any illness causing loss of appetite.

HELMETS AND VESTS

All riders should be aware of the following rules pertaining to the requirements whilst mounted on a horse. Please be aware this includes beaches and unregistered premises.

AR.87. Every licensed or registered person or permit holder shall when mounted on a horse wear a properly affixed helmet which conforms to one of the standards that have been approved by the Australian Racing Board. [amended 1.10.00 & 3.11.03][amended 1.10.06]

Note: Pursuant to AR.87 the Australian Racing Board has ordered that -

- (a) The following standards are approved by the Australian Racing Board:
- (i) AS/NZS 3838 2003;
 - (ii) United States (US) ASTM F11 63-01;
 - (iii) British Standards (BS) EN 1384/1996 onwards.
- (b) all helmets must be fitted with a nylon interlocking chinstrap clip attachment.
- (c) all helmets must be clearly marked with a date of manufacture.
- (d) the use of helmets is subject to the conditions of Australian Rule of Racing 87AA.

AR.87B.

- (1) Every rider shall when mounted on a horse wear a properly fastened safety vest the standard of which has been prescribed by Order of the Board. Provided that every such safety vest shall be in a satisfactory condition and shall have attached to it a manufacturer's label that states that it complies with the relevant standard prescribed by the Board. [amended 14.6.07 & 1.8.07]
- (2) The Stewards may confiscate or order the satisfactory repair of any safety vest that does not comply with the requirements of subrule (1). [rule replaced 1.3.2000] [sub-rule (2) added 1.12.05][amended 1.8.07]

Note: Pursuant to AR.87B, the Australian Racing Board has ordered that the following standards of safety vests are prescribed: ARB Standard 1.1998; SATRA Jockey Vest standard; European Standard EN 13158 level 1.

FOOTWEAR

It has come to the attention of Stewards that a number of participants who are leading horses are wearing shoes that do not conform to the following rule. If any person is found to be wearing inappropriate or unsuitable footwear will be stood down immediately.

AR.87A. (3) Every person leading or attending a horse shall wear fully enclosed and substantial footwear of a standard approved by the Stewards.

Steward's Segment

GEAR

Pacifiers

Pacifiers will now be permitted to be worn on rain affected and heavy tracks. However, the discretion of the Stewards will still apply upon request.

Approval for use: Pacifiers are approved for use for the purposes of AR.140B, subject to the conditions set out in this rule.

Specifications: Pacifiers must be a strong mesh that will resume normal shape after compression.

Proper application: Pacifiers must be worn under the bridle.

Track conditions: The Stewards may order the removal of pacifiers if in their opinion the track conditions are adverse to such use.

VISITING TRAINERS

Under Australian Rule 80 any person who is the holder of a trainer licence or permit to train in another State or Territory may for a period of one month from his arrival train horses in Tasmania as a Visiting Trainer. Any such licence or permit to train shall be produced on request. Permission must be gained for an extension of that period of time. If permission is not granted the person must make application for a Tasmanian Trainer's licence.

Trainers should contact Racing Services Tasmania on 6336 2450 prior to their arrival in the State to obtain the necessary application form and provide any other relevant information which may be required.

VISITING INTERSTATE APPRENTICE JOCKEYS

Any apprentice jockey wishing to ride at Tasmanian meetings should contact the Racing Operations Department of Racing Services Tasmania on 6336 2450 for full details of requirements and to obtain the necessary forms.

The following is required to be submitted before processing can be actioned –

- Fully completed Visiting Apprentice Notification form
- Next of Kin information
- Emergency Medical Information
- Letter from Master granting permission for the apprentice to ride in Tasmania at a particular meeting. (This is required for insurance purposes)
- RST will obtain medical and clearance information from the relevant state authority.

Apprentice notifications must be completed to the satisfaction of RST by close of business at least one (1) clear working day prior to the race meeting.

Failure to provide the above information may mean that the Apprentice may not be permitted to ride which would inconvenience all participants involved.

STABLE EMPLOYEES & TRACKWORK RIDERS

Trainers and participants should be aware that although a person may hold a Stable Employee and/or Trackwork Riders licence with another jurisdiction they are not permitted to automatically work in Tasmania and **MUST** make application to be registered in Tasmania.

On arrival in the state participants should **IMMEDIATELY** contact Racing Services Tasmania on 6336 2450 to obtain the necessary application forms to be licensed.

Once the completed form has been lodged, RST will contact the state authority where the person was previously registered to obtain a copy of a medical (if submitted) and a clearance to be licensed.

Participants should be aware that it is a requirement for persons performing trackwork in Tasmania to submit a medical examination report annually as part of their application. This may not be the case with all other jurisdictions. Persons applying for a licence for the first time in Tasmania must undergo a trackwork assessment with Stewards prior to being licensed.

Trainers are reminded that it is an offence to have an unregistered person performing stable employee and trackwork rider duties as part of their training activities.

Stable Employees and Trackwork Riders visiting Tasmania with a Registered Visiting Trainer are permitted to perform those roles for that trainer only without full registration in Tasmania. The Visiting Trainer is required to submit details of his stable employees as part of his registration.

International Applicants must also provide a copy of their passport and visa which indicates they have immigration permission to work in Australia.

“(2) The Registrar may allow or reject any application for registration of any horse. The fees payable for registration of a horse shall be such as are determined from time to time by the Board of RISA.”

A duplicate Document of Description or Thoroughbred Identification Card may, on payment of the fee prescribed by the Board of RISA, be issued by the Registrar if he is satisfied on the evidence received that such Document of Description or Thoroughbred Identification Card was lost, destroyed or for some other reason cannot be produced.”

AR.69H (xii). Amended, effective 1st November 2011 (words deleted and replaced).

“(xii) The fees to be paid in relation to a syndicate, with the level of those fees being as prescribed by the Board of RISA.”

“AR.690. In cases where a syndicate has owned, part owned or leased a horse, and that syndicate now wishes to own, part own or lease a subsequent horse, a separate notification must be lodged in respect of each subsequent horse and each notification must be accompanied by the fee prescribed from time to time by the Board of RISA. No application to register a racehorse, endorse a transfer or record a lease will be accepted unless accompanied by the separate notification form, together with the prescribed fee.”

AR.136(2). Amended, effective 1st November 2011 (words deleted and replaced).

“136(2) If a placed horse or its rider causes interference within the meaning of this Rule to another placed horse, or its rider, and the stewards are of the opinion that the horse interfered with would have finished ahead of the first mentioned horse had such interference not occurred, they may place the first mentioned horse immediately after the horse interfered with. For the purpose of this Rule “placed horse” shall be a horse placed by the Judge in accordance with AR.157.”

Australian Rule Amendments

AR.103. Existing Rule deleted and replaced with the following (effective 1st January 2012):

- (1) The top weight allocated for handicap flat races must not be less than 59 kilograms, except for Group 1 handicap races and races in which 2yos only can run, for which the allocated top weight must not be less than 58 kilograms.
- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subrule (1), if at the declaration of acceptances for a handicap flat race the weight allocated to the highest-weighted acceptor (including any extra weight by way of re-handicap or penalty) is less than 58 kilograms, then allocated weights for the race must be increased until the highest-weighted acceptor is weighted at 58 kilograms
- (3) The minimum weight allocated for handicap flat races must not be less than –
 - (a) 50 kilograms for the Melbourne Cup and Caulfield Cup;

Provided that the Principal Racing Authority concerned may approve applications made by racing clubs for 2-year-old and/or 3-year old horses in open-age handicap races to be allocated lower minimum weights than those prescribed by paragraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d) of this subrule.

Local Rule Amendments

PRE-TRAINING RULE

New Local Rule 15.18

“A horse having been in the care of a person for pre-training shall not be eligible to start in a trial or race unless the horse had been placed in the care of the notified Trainer at the registered stables of the Trainer no later than seven (7) days prior to trialling and or no later than twenty eight (28) days prior to racing. For the purpose of this rule a horse engaged in “pre-training” shall mean a horse being in the care of and exercised, worked or trained by a person, whether the holder of a Trainer’s Licence or not, on or from a property other than the registered stables of the notified Trainer.”

NIGHT RACING SCRATCHING TIMES

Local Rule 14.1. Amended

Notwithstanding the provisions of AR.114, no horse shall be withdrawn from a race for which it is an acceptor in respect of a race meeting where the scheduled starting time of the first race is –

(a) Before 4.00 pm: 7.30 am on that day;

Without the permission of the Stewards or as per LR15.4 (a), (b) or (c). (LR34(a) amdt effective 01/12/2009)

REVIEW OF TRACK SAFETY LIMITS

MAIDEN/MAIDEN CLASS 1 BALLOT PROCEDURE

LR.11.1(a)(i) Balloting conditions and order of entry for Maiden and Maiden/Class 1 races are as follows, and where necessary, horses equal for the ballot will be eliminated by lot:

1. First starters;
2. Placed 1st last start;
3. Placed 2nd last start;
4. Placed 3rd last start;
5. Horses subject to Balloted Out List conditions and rankings (refer LR11(a)(ii)&(iii) below)
6. Placed 4th or 5th last start or only had 1 career start;
7. Placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at their second last start.

LR.11(a)(ii) Maiden horses that have had fewer than 11 race starts and are balloted out (or fail to gain a start as an emergency) on two successive occasions in Maiden or Maiden/Class 1 races are placed on the Balloted Out List and ranked in ascending order by the date they were balloted on the second occasion. Horses with the same second balloted out date are ranked according to the least number of unplaced runs, and then by lot, if equal. Horses that gain a start and are subsequently scratched from the race will only retain their position on the Balloted Out List on presentation of a veterinary certificate. Abandoned, cancelled or deleted races are not considered for Balloted Out listing purposes.

LR.11(a)(iii) The ballot out list will not be implemented on the following race days: Devonport Cup day, Tasmanian Derby day, Hobart Cup day and Launceston Cup day.

LR.11(a)(iv) The Maiden Balloting Conditions will be declared at the declaration of weights only. start as an emergency) on two successive occasions in Maiden or Maiden/Class 1 races are placed on the Balloted Out List and ranked in ascending order by the date they were balloted on the second occasion. Horses with the same second balloted out date are ranked according to the least number of unplaced runs, and then by lot, if equal. Horses that gain a start and are subsequently scratched from the race will retain their position on the Balloted Out list. Abandoned, cancelled or deleted races are not considered for Balloted Out listing purposes.

Stridemaster

StrideMaster is a revolutionary tracking system developed to measure a horse's performance on raceday through GPS and precision sensor data. Recorded continuously, StrideMaster combines timing, positional data and physical performance measures for every horse on raceday. The data is summarised over 200 metre intervals.

HOW TO INTERPRET STRIDEMASTER DATA

POSITION IN RUNNING
Position in running is the horse's actual position during the race at each designated 200 metre section.

SECTIONAL TIME (Seconds)
Time taken between two points on the track, 200 metres apart.

CUMULATIVE TIME (Seconds)
The cumulative time taken at each sectional marker in the race.

SPEED (Metres per Second)
Average speed measured over each 200 metre section.

STRIDE LENGTH (Metres)
Stride length is the individual length of a horse's stride. The figure presented is an average stride length for each 200m section. [Stride Length = 200m ÷ Stride Count]

STRIDE DURATION (Seconds)
Stride Duration is the time taken for the horse to take each stride. The figure presented is an average stride duration for each 200m section. [Stride Duration = Sectional Time ÷ Stride Count]

STRIDE EFFICIENCY (%)
Measures the relationship between stride length, stride duration and speed. The figure presented is benchmarked against an elite racehorse running 11 second 200m sections. [Stride Efficiency = (Stride Length ÷ by 8m), x (Stride Duration ÷ 0.44), x (Speed ÷ 18.18m/s), x 100]

STRIDE COUNT
Stride Count is the total number of strides taken in each 200m section. [Stride Count = Number of Strides]

These figures reflect the average of the horse's overall performance for the race. For example this horse had an average stride length of 6.87m throughout the race.

Why do we need a new bonus scheme?

For many years, the Tasmanian scheme has been closely aligned to RVL's (Racing Victoria Limited) SuperVOBIS scheme and partially subsidised by RVL. A change in funding arrangements with RVL for the Tasmanian scheme has necessitated the implementation of the new tasBonus scheme. Continued support for Tasmanian owners and breeders is consistent with Tasracing's Corporate Plan.

The "SuperVOBIS" working group committee which included representatives from TasBreeders and Thoroughbred Racehorse Owners Association (TROA), agreed upon the structure and details of the new scheme.

Eligibility

Yearlings that qualify for the scheme are:

- Tasmanian-sired (Tasmanian-based sire)
- Tasmanian-bred (mare must be Tasmanian-owned), based on Australian Stud Book registered breeder location
- Catalogued for sale at the Tasmanian Yearling Sale (any breeding)

Costs

Breeder Nomination: \$220 (incl GST)

Owner Nomination: \$330 (incl GST)

A horse may be only breeder nominated or only owner nominated or both.

The dual nomination shares the costs between both parties and reduces the overall cost from \$600 (previous SuperVOBIS) to \$500 (tasBonus).

A once-off fee is paid to Tasracing when the horse is a yearling and the horse then becomes eligible for a bonus whilst it is a 2, 3 and 4 year old, for its maiden win or for one of any special bonus races.

Key Facts

- The new thoroughbred Tasmanian Bonus Scheme (tasBonus) will commence on 1 August 2011 for foals born in 2010, replacing the current SuperVOBIS (Tas) scheme. The new scheme will have significant advantages for Tasmanian Owners and Breeders.
- Tasracing will honour the current arrangements with the SuperVOBIS scheme for horses born in 2008/09.
- The changes are required due to a change in funding arrangements with Racing Victoria Limited (RVL) under the current SuperVOBIS scheme.
- The new scheme reaffirms Tasracing's commitment to the thoroughbred breeding industry.
- The new tasBonus scheme allows for a dual nomination process by both breeders and owners, with both receiving bonuses when a horse wins an appropriate race.
- Additional "Double Up Sale Vouchers" and "Special Bonus Races" will also be available through tasBonus.

Special Bonus Races

In addition, owners and breeders will receive an additional \$4,000 (\$3,000 owner/\$1,000 breeder) bonus for non-maiden horses winning specified 2YO and 3YO races (under \$50,000). A maiden winning a specified race will however only be eligible for its maiden bonus (i.e. The special race bonus will not apply). These will include four feature 2YO races, three feature 3YO races and approximately 16 open 2YO and 3YO races throughout the season.

Mainland Sale Horses

Under the new tasBonus scheme, interstate-sired horses purchased at mainland sales or as tried racehorses will no longer be eligible for the bonuses.

Commencement of the tasBonus Scheme

The tasBonus scheme will be implemented for horses turning one year of age on 1 August 2011 (foaled in 2010). Tasracing will honour the current arrangements with the SuperVOBIS Scheme for this season's (and prior) yearlings.

The new tasBonus scheme does not pay bonuses for any horses that win or are placed in SuperVOBIS bonus races run in Victoria. However, in order to cater for those wishing to have access to these bonuses, a separate scheme SuperVOBIS (Tas) will operate in conjunction with the new tasBonus scheme and be administered by Tasracing.

The SuperVOBIS (Tas) scheme will be available to nominators of Tasmanian sired horses only and will operate under the same fee, bonus and dead-line structure as the existing Victorian scheme. This will allow breeders targeting interstate purchasers to enhance their yearling with Victorian SuperVOBIS endowments.

There is no association between RVL Victorian SuperVOBIS Scheme and Tasracing's SuperVOBIS (Tas) Scheme and as such Victorian sired horses need to be nominated and paid through RVL to be eligible for the SuperVOBIS Victorian Scheme.

Double Up Sale Voucher Option

The new scheme will also feature a "Double Up Sale Voucher" facility for owners (this feature does not apply to breeders). These will allow the winning owners of specified races as mentioned above, the option of converting their \$3,000 cash bonus into a \$6,000 sale credit. This credit must be redeemed at the subsequent Tasmanian Yearling Sale. Owners will be given 14 days to notify whether they would like their \$3,000 cash bonus converted into a \$6,000 sale credit. Conditions apply, please refer to www.tasracing.com.au for more information.

Winning Bonus payments are restricted to owners and breeders only, as detailed in the table above.

This bonus differs from the original SuperVOBIS scheme by increasing the bonus from \$3,000 (SuperVOBIS) to \$4,000 (tasBonus) for 2YO and 3YO horses. Unlike the previous SuperVOBIS scheme, neither trainers nor jockeys are eligible for a bonus payment under the tasBonus scheme.

Benchmark Races in Tasmania

What is a Benchmark Race?

- A benchmark race is a Handicap based on rating
- There is no upper or lower limit on eligibility. In simple terms a benchmark race is open to all horses
- The weights assigned to each entry relate to the benchmark rating assigned to the race

Where are Benchmark Races currently run?

Benchmark races were first introduced in South Africa in 1999 and then in Singapore in 2002. They are also run in Dubai and Japan. In Australia they were introduced into NSW racing in October 2009.

How do Benchmark Races vary from ratings based races currently run in Tasmania?

The main point of difference between Benchmark races and ratings based (RB) races conducted is eligibility. As an example: in a 0-75 RB race only horses rated 75 and below can enter. A horse rated 75 will receive 59kg. Any horse with a rating higher than 75 is ineligible. In a Benchmark 78 race any horse can enter (irrespective of rating). A horse rated 78 will receive 59kg. A horse rated 79 is eligible and will carry 59.5kg (i.e. an additional 0.5kg for each point over the Benchmark number). A horse rated 80 will carry 60kg and so on.

Fillies and Mares Allowance

When competing against male horses fillies and mares shall receive a 2.0kg weight allowance.

3YO Allowance

When 3YO's race against older horses they will receive a weight allowance which is a sliding scale adjusted quarterly from an initial 2.5kg in August to nil by the end of the season. This reflects on the developing maturity of 3YO's as the season progresses. When competing in open class races the Handicapper will assess their form against the current WFA scale to determine an appropriate allowance if any.

The elimination order for both races is exactly the same. The construction of weights for both races are exactly the same other than in Benchmark races each point over the 59kg Benchmark rating is the equivalent of an extra 0.5kg in weight.

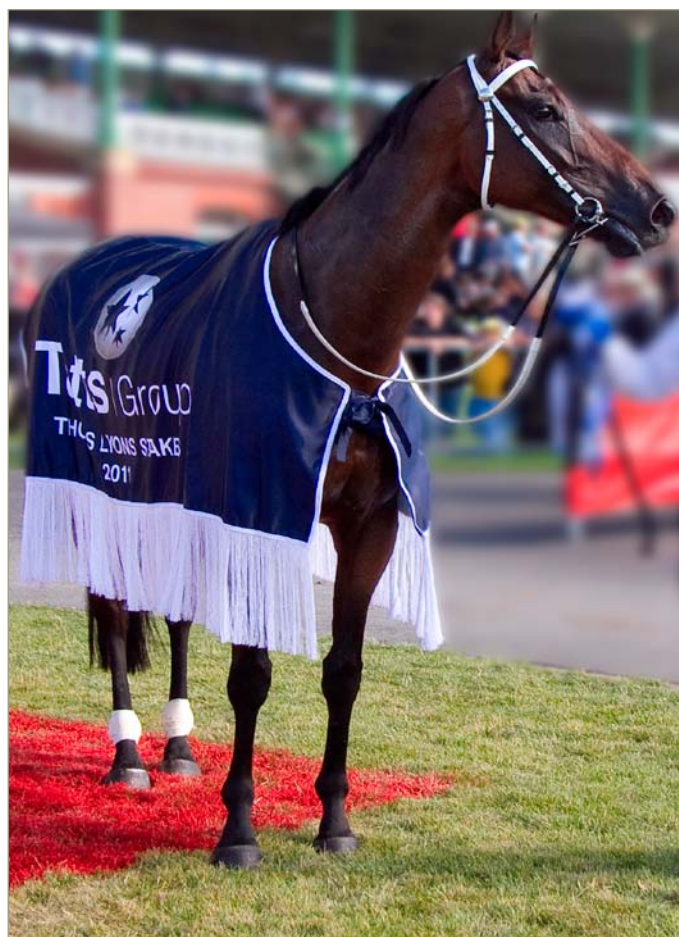
While the Benchmark weight for races in Tasmania will be 59kg the same policies with regard to minimum top weight at declaration of weights 59kg and minimum top weight at final acceptance (59kg in all races) would continue to apply. As an example if the highest rate horse entered for a Benchmark 78 race was a horse rated 77 (normally 58.5kg) he would be allocated 59kg and all other weights would be adjusted accordingly (+0.5kg).

What are the benefits of Benchmark Races?

- Creates more opportunities for industry participants to place their horses by reducing the restrictions on eligibility.
- Likely to have a modest positive impact on field sizes as horses which may have not been catered for in a particular week might source a suitable benchmark race in which they can enter and run with a high weight.
- Benchmark races open the top of the weight scale providing bigger spreads in weights, in turn, theoretically delivering more competitive races with additional form lines driving wagering.

A Must Read For Horse Riders | Let's Take the Brain Injuries Out of Races

Concussion Facts

- Concussion is a brain injury that alters the way your brain functions.
- Concussion can occur from a blow to the head/body:
 - Following helmet to helmet contact, and/or
 - Contact with the ground, object or another athlete.
- Most concussions occur without being knocked unconscious.
- Severity of injury depends on many factors and is not known until symptoms resolve and brain function is back to normal.
- All concussions are not created equally. Each athlete is different, each injury is different, and your team medical staff should evaluate all injuries.

Concussion Symptoms

Different symptoms can occur and may not show up for several hours.

Common symptoms include:

- Confusion
- Headache
- Amnesia/difficulty remembering
- Balance problems
- Irritability
- Dizziness
- Difficulty concentrating
- Feeling sluggish, foggy, or groggy
- Loss of consciousness
- Nausea
- Sensitivity to noise
- Sensitivity to light
- Double/fuzzy vision
- Slowed reaction time
- Feeling more emotional
- Sleep disturbances

Why Should I Report My Symptoms?

- Your brain is the most vital organ in your body.
- Training or racing while still experiencing symptoms can prolong the time it takes to recover and return to race.
- Unlike other injuries, there may be significant consequences to “racing through” a concussion.
- Respective brain injury, when not managed promptly and properly, may cause permanent damage to your brain.

Symptoms may worsen with physical or mental exertion (e.g. lifting, computer use, reading).

What Should I do if I Think I've had a Concussion?

REPORT IT

NEVER ignore symptoms even if they appear mild.

Look out for your helpers. Tell your trainer if you think you or another athlete may have a concussion.

GET CHECKED OUT

Your trainer, stewards, and fellow jockeys have your health and well being as their first priority.

Your concussion should be managed according to your Principal Racing Authority and the Australian Racing Board (ARB) guidelines. These include being fully asymptomatic, both at rest and after exertion, having a normal neurologic examination, normal Computerised Cognitive Assessment Tool (CCAT) testing (Axon Sport Test), and clearance to ride by the PRA medical staff which may include the clearance from an independent neurologic consultant.

TAKE CARE OF YOUR BRAIN

According to the Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), “traumatic brain injury can cause a wide range of short or long-term changes affecting thinking, sensation, language, or emotions”.

These changes may lead to problems with memory and communication, personality changes, as well as depression and the early onset of dementia. Concussions and conditions resulting from repeated brain injury can change your life and your family's forever.
